

OPCAT inspection in the Somogy County Prison



On 24 and 25 June 2015, the delegation of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism visited the Somogy County Prison in Kaposvár. The main purpose of the inspection was to follow up the implementation of the recommendations of the European Committee for the Prevention of Torture and Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment (CPT) made in 2013.¹ The delegation inspected, among others, the cell blocks, and conducted confidential interviews with the adult and young detainees and the institution's personnel.
