OPCAT visit

to the Living Home of the Integrated Care Center of Tolna County 4 June 2020

On 4 June 2020 the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights, who is responsible for performing the tasks of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism (hereinafter referred to as the "NPM") and his colleagues paid a visit to the Living Home of the Integrated Care Center of Tolna County in Regöly.





The purpose of the visit was to inspect the measures taken to prevent the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) and to tackle the epidemic. The NPM inspected the living conditions of the inhabitants living with disability, and enquired about the steps taken by the management and the staff in order to minimize the impact of the restrictions imposed during the pandemic (e.g. ban on visiting and leaving the institution).
