

OPCAT visit to the official premises of Siklós Police Department, Unit II, the official premises of the Central and Gyárvárosi Police Stations of Pécs Police Department, and the lock-up unit of Komló Police Department

17-18 September, 2018

On September 17-18, 2018, staff members of the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights performing the duties of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism paid an unannounced visit to the official premises of Siklós Police Department, Unit II, the official premises of the Central and Gyárvárosi Police Stations of Pécs Police Department, and the lock-up unit of Komló Police Department.



The objective of the visit was the inspection of the treatment of detainees and the conditions of detention. Members of the visiting delegation inspected the premises of the police buildings, their furnishing and equipment; they also examined the relevant documents and conducted interviews with the management and the staff members.

At the time of the visit, no persons deprived of their liberty were present at the places of detention.
